

## Medical Scenario #1

**Case Scenario:** Altered mental status

**Call Time:** 4:00pm

**Scene Information:** Living room of a family residence. Scene is safe.

**Victim Information:** Patient is a 35 y/o female who is disoriented to her surroundings and family member called 911.

**AVPU:** Disoriented to surroundings

**S/S:** generalized weakness

**A:** PCN

**M:** none

**P:** Gallbladder surgery; family history of diabetes

**L:** small lunch

**E:** working in the yard

### Assessment Findings:

**HEENT:** clear

**Pupils:** PEARL

**Lungs:** CTA

**Upper extremities:** good PMS no injuries

**Chest and Abdomen:** soft, non-tender, non-remarkable

**Pelvis:** non-tender, non-remarkable

**Lower extremities:** good PMS no injuries

**Back:** no injuries

**V/S:** B/P: 110/80; P: 98; R: 24 unlabored; Skin: diaphoretic

### Treatment:

V/S

SAMPLE

Oxygen

Blood glucose test – 40 mg/dcL

Oral glucose via order from medical control

### Additional Information:

Non critical patient

Re-assess every 15 minutes

### Outcome:

If pt is treated correctly on scene, pt can have return of LOC to GCS of 15 and refuse transport
