

## Medical Scenario #2

**Case Scenario:** Cardiac Arrest

**Call Time:** 9:00pm

**Scene Information:** Bedroom of a family residence. Scene is safe.

**Victim Information:** Patient is a 68 y/o male who collapsed in the bedroom while preparing to go to bed. Wife immediately called 911

**AVPU:** Unresponsive

**S/S:** No pulse or respirations found

**A:** ASA

**M:** Nitroglycerin (PRN), blood pressure pill

**P:** Angina, Hypertension, and cardiac bypass surgery 3 years ago

**L:** supper

**E:** preparing for bed

### Assessment Findings:

**HEENT:** clear

**Pupils:** Dilated and fixed

**Lungs:** no breaths sounds noted

**Upper extremities:** no detectable pulse; capillary refill slow

**Chest and Abdomen:** soft, non-tender, non-remarkable

**Pelvis:** non-tender, non-remarkable

**Lower extremities:** no detectable pulse; capillary refill slow

**Back:** no injuries

**V/S:** B/P: 0; P: 0; R: 0 Skin: cyanotic

### Treatment:

ABC's

Oral airway

BVM w/Oxygen

Combitube

CPR

AED

Long spine board

### Additional Information:

Call for ALS support immediately

Critical patient

Re-assess every 5 minutes
