

Paramedic Skills Days Schedule
PERCOM EMS Academy
Practice Sessions – Instructor Version

This schedule is designed for 16 hour blocks of training for the online portions of training. It may be divided in smaller blocks as indicated, but should include the following skills at a minimum. ALL students are required to practice all the skills listed FIRST. Testing must be achieved on separate days at a later date. If students are to attend Practice Sessions but are there to test, a second instructor should be available to do testing only. Students who are testing should not take away teaching/practice time from students who are there for their practice session(s). Testing of all skills can typically be achieved in one or two days. Students will not be allowed to register for clinical and field rotations until after the second Practice Session and ONLY IF the Lead Instructor from that second session clears the student as having demonstrated a minimum level of safe and competent performance to help ensure patient safety in the clinical and field environments AND have successfully completed both the Pharmacology and ECG Qualifying proctored Exams. Students who are not cleared by the Lead Instructor will be required to attend another Practice Session and be cleared by the Lead Skills Instructor prior to starting rotations, after paying the Rescheduling Fee of \$225. Students who failed one or both of the Qualifying Exams may take these at the Testing Session OR may be given the option of taking them by appointment at a designated site and must pay any associated testing fees for the service but will NOT be allowed to begin rotations until these have been successfully completed.
